#### How family day care prepares children for school

Family day care services are ideal environments for children to develop the qualities needed to succeed in all areas of life, including school. Family day care does not need to turn into a 'school environment' to prepare children for school. Supporting children's school readiness is about assisting them to develop their skills in areas such as literacy, numeracy and self-care when they are ready for this, and at their own pace, as well as social skills, emotional literacy, physical development, and resilience. By supporting all areas of children's development and focusing on building strong, responsive relationships with them, child care professionals can provide children with the skills and confidence to continue along a path of life-long learning.
