## What does the National Quality Framework mean for your child?

As mentioned in our October Parent Update, Wynnum FDC has been assessed and rated against the NQF this year and received the overall rating of Exceeding. This is the second time we have been through the assessment and rating process (and to have received the Exceeding rating) under the current legislation which was introduced in 2012. Services are assessed and rated against seven quality areas including educational program and practice, children's health and safety, physical environment, staffing arrangements, relationships with children, collaborative partnerships with families and communities, and leadership and service management.
