Jobs for Families Child Care Package

Prime Minister Malcolm Turnbull announced a reform of childcare subsidies would be a priority for his Government in 2017. The Prime Minister recognised that many families are only just managing financially and that increased support with childcare costs in urgently needed. In the next few days and possibly weeks, the Jobs for Families Package Childcare Package Bill will be put to both houses of parliament to make a decision. The biggest hurdle will be when this Bill goes to the Senate and we will see how various Senators react to it. There is a mix of Senators who oppose, support and are also undecided about this Bill. The difficulty with this Childcare Package Bill and a key reason for the delay is the government have decided to tie the funding of this Childcare Package Bill to making cuts to the Family Tax Benefit (FTB). That is, they will take money from FTB families in order to pay the families childcare subsidy.
